- The County Executive was looking at one insurance package all councils could buy into. It was found that the county cannot bid the project as the councils are separate legal entities. A sample package has prepared by procurement if multiple councils wish to do a joint package. The county may give grants to offset costs.
- FY 2014 Capitol Budget request was put in at the September Presidents meeting. Norrisville requested \$500,000 for development of Norrisville park.

- Joe Gast will continue as Baseball/Softball Chair and Tony Weaver will continue as Soccer Chair.
